We wrote you on the 3^d March requesting you to send us immediately the full Proportion of the Foxes Cargoe of Sugar in your Hands. We therefore desire you to comply with that requisition as the Sugars we received from you are all exhausted and the constant Demands from the Officers require that we should have in our Possession all the Sugars belonging to the State.
