That the said Treasurer deliver to Stephen Steward Esq^r five hh^{ds} of Tobacco five thousand two hundred and thirty eight pounds net on Account.

That the Issuing Commissary deliver to Lieut Rignal Hilliary thirty two Gallons of Rum and one hundred and twenty eight pounds of Sugar due him to 1st Inst.

That James Calhoun Esq^r Commissary General for the western shore deliver to Stephen Steward Esq^r ten barrels of Flour and five barrels of Bread to be expended in building the Galley & to be by him Accounted for.

That the Armour deliver to Capt George Keepports fifty Gun Locks and forty ramrods for repairing Arms in Baltimore
