Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to Lieut Isaac Rawlings Lieut William Murdock, Lieut John Boone and Capt. Archibald McCallister each Linen for two shirts for the present year. and also to Captain John Mitchell two and a quarter yards Russia Duck to be charged to him.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to James Williams four hundred and eighty two pounds, eleven shillings and two pence Specie agreeable to the " Act to adjust the Debts due from the State " due him p Account passed by the Dep^y Auditor.

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to Jonathan Parker two pounds seven shillings of the Bills emitted under the " Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand Pounds on the security of Double the Value in Lands to defray the Expences of the present Campaign " in lieu of two pounds seven shillings specie due on Account passed by the Dep^y Aud. p. 100

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Munro Thirteen pounds, four shillings and six pence of the same Emission p Accounts passed by the Dep^y Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to George Adams four pounds fifteen shillings and eight pence sixteen pounds four shillings and one penny and thirteen pounds seventeen shillings and six pence of the same Emission due him p Accounts passed by the D. Aud.
