That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Winchester and Capt. Thomas Mason, each fifteen pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds &^{ca} part of the money appropriated to the Officers going to the Southward.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. David Lynn of the 4th and Capt Robert Denny of the 5th Regim^t each, Twenty pounds of the same Emission part of the money appropriated as aforesaid.
