Tuesday 21st August 1781

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Henry Murphy seven Pounds ten shillings of the Bills emitted under the "Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding 200,000^{ls} &^{ca}" of the money appropriated for the present Campaign to be delivered over to Richard Dallam Commissary for Harford County & by him accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to Ignatius Montgomery, one Pound five shillings of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due him for rations per Account passed by the Dep^y Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Hezekiah Wheeler one hundred and fifty six Pounds, thirteen shillings and ten pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid for the use of his Company of Select Militia per Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Horatio Clagett fourteen Pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid for Clothing on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Marshall Seventy six Pounds, eight shillings and two pence Specie agreeable to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l

That the said Treasurer deliver to Col^o Samuel Smith two hundred hogsheds of Tobacco to be accounted for.
