That the said Treasurer pay to Col<sup>o</sup> George Dashiell Five hundred pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid to be by him expended in the Purchase of Pork and accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Col<sup>o</sup> George Dashiell Two hundred Pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated as afores<sup>d</sup> to be delivered over to Peter Chaille Commissary of Worcester County to be expended in the purchase of Barrel<sup>d</sup> Pork and accounted for.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Adam Ott one hundred and Sixty five Pounds, eleven shillings and eight pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated as aforesaid due himself and Company of Select Militia and also the further sum of thirty two Pounds like money as above due him per Accounts passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup> and Dep<sup>y</sup> Aud.
