By Information this Day received from his Excellency Gen^l Washington of a Detachment of the main Army marching towards Virginia under his immediate Command, and urges the immediate Equip- ment and March of the Levies at this Place, and before they can move, it will be necessary to furnish them with Blankets and Shoes; we therefore earnestly request you to purchase or otherwise procure all the Blankets, or Cloth proper for Blankets and Shoes in Baltimore Town, and have them delivered to Cap^t Keepports who will forward them; we flatter ourselves from the Importance of the Service every good Citizen will chearfully sell the Articles required.
