The Goods which M<sup>r</sup> Richard Lemmon has secreted or sent out of the way to prevent you from seizing them and executing the Law, are forfeited to the State, or the Value thereof, so that it will be necessary for you to give Information to two Justices of the Peace, that Lemmon was possessed of such Goods and offered them for Sale and hath since concealed them to frustrate the Act of last Session to procure an immediate Supply of Cloathing &<sup>ca</sup> The ninth Section of the Law empowers the Justices to take Cognizance of this Matter and to give Judgment against Lemmon for the Goods so secreted as the Value thereof for the use of the State. We are informed Lemmon is possessed of 500 Pairs of Leather Breeches, you are hereby authorized and requested to seize them immediately, if he will not sell them to the State for the same Price for which he offered them to Col<sup>o</sup> Smith, which is thirty five shillings a Pair. You will send down the Blankets and Cloathing Tomorrow, or as soon as possible
