That the said Treasurer pay to Jacob Crist one hundred and forty two pounds of the same Emission of the money aforesaid due him per Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l and also sixteen pounds, eight shillings and six pence to be delivered over to Capt. Charles Baltzel in Lieu of an order of the 19th September 1780.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. Nicholas Ruxton Moore four hundred and sixty four pounds, seven shillings and six pence of the same Emission of the money aforesaid for the use of his Troop of light Horse due them for their Services when ordered to George Town and Virginia per pay rolls examined and passed by the A. Gen^l

That the said Treasurer pay to Alexander Clagett Esq^r sixty pounds one shilling and four pence of the same Emission of the money aforesaid to be delivered over to Henry Shryock per Account passed by the Aud^r Gen^l

That the said Treasurer pay to Nicholas Thomas Esq^r one hundred and twenty five pounds of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defence of the State on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Col^o Blaine Seventy five pounds Specie to be deliv^d over to James Calhoun Esq^r to enable him to purchase Flour Barrells &^{ca} on Acc^t
