That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut John Lavascher six pounds, nine shillings of the same Emission for Stores to 1 April next on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to M<sup>rs</sup> Frances Gover sixty five pounds, sixteen shillings and four pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from the State per Certificate adjusted & passed 22<sup>d</sup> Inst.—

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Harwood Esq<sup>r</sup> sixty five pounds, sixteen shillings and five pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &<sup>ca</sup> due him on a Certificate issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State

Ordered that the Armourer receive of Commodore Grason the Arms he brought from the E Shore and deliver him the like Number or have them returned.—

That the western shore Treasurer pay to William Gray two hundred & thirty six pounds, eleven shillings & ten pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Certificate adjusted & passed.—

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Cromwell, twenty three pounds, seventeen shillings and six pence—John Grahame Esq<sup>r</sup> for the use of Doct<sup>r</sup> James Gray sixty seven pounds eighteen shillings and to Aquila Wilson nine pounds of the Bill & emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &<sup>ca</sup> due them per Accounts passed.—

That the said Treasurer pay to John Grahame two hundred and thirty six pounds, eleven shillings and ten pence of the same Emission for the use of William Gray due him on a Certifi<sup>a</sup> issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State.—

That the Issuing Commissary deliver to Capt Elisha Lathrop three Days rations for twelve men prisoners returned on board the Flag Schooner Polly from Charles Town South Carolina to enable them to proceed to the Southward.—
