We request you to supply each of them immediately with a complete Suit of Cloathing consisting of the Articles in the enclosed Return, and to take Measures for providing Suits for about one hundred and eighty more, eighty of whom are dispersed about the State, and the others soon expected from the Southward.

1 Coat, 1 Vest, 1 p<sup>r</sup> Breeches or two Pair of Linen Overalls, 2 Shirts, 2 Pair of Stockings, 1 p<sup>r</sup> Shoes, 1 Hat, and Blanket; if they have Linen Overalls, they will not want Breeches or Stockings.
