That the said Treasurer pay to Samuel Dare twenty five Pounds, one shilling and nine pence and James M. Sollars seventy one Pounds, seventeen shillings Specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State per Certificates adjusted & passed.

That Henry Dickinson Esq^r Treasurer of the Eastern shore pay to the Western shore Treasurer, one thousand seven hundred and fifty three Pounds, thirteen shillings and nine pence old Continental Currency, seven thousand one hundred and twenty seven pounds, two shillings of the Bills of Credit of the Emission of June 1780, and also fifteen thousand four hundred and thirty six pounds, thirteen shillings six pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &^{ca}—two hundred and thirteen thousand, eight hundred and twenty one Pounds of Crop and fifteen thousand two hundred and nineteen pounds of Transfer Tobacco.
