[Council to Henry Hollingsworth]

We have yours of the 6th Instant, in Consequence of which, we have ordered M^r Calhoun to sell Flour to raise Money to purchase about one hundred Bushels of Salt for you; should that Quantity be more than you want, you will distribute it among the Commissaries on the Eastern Shore, most in Need of it. You will continue to slaughter and salt up the Cattle as long as they are fit to be slaughtered. We shall send you some red Money by M^r Job. It will be proper that you supply Col^o Yates with Forage, as long as you have it in your Power
