p. 301 Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Richard Frazier fourteen Pounds four shillings of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &^{ca}, ten Pounds, two shillings thereof to be delivered over to Nicholas Rowe and four Pounds, two shillings to William Dormand due them per Accounts passed.
