In order to keep up proper Supplies at the Magazine, we have in our Letter to the Intendant, of this Date, requested him to furnish you with whatever may be necessary for that Purposc. We also appoint you to act as Paymaster to the Barges, and to enable you to execute the Duties thereof, you are hereby authorized to call upon the Commanding Officers for Pay Rolls and Returns of the Men, agreeable to such Forms as you shall direct, which, with the proper Vouchers for your Payments, are to be laid before this Board.
