That the said Treasurer pay to George Miller ten Pounds sixteen shillings and eight Pence, John O'Conner eleven Pounds ten shillings, Joseph Davis three Pounds, twelve shillings and six Pence, & John Shaw one hundred and one Pounds, two shillings & two Pence, specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" per Accounts passed.
