 No. 24 sixty seven Pounds, seven shillings and six Pence specie agreeable
 p. 336 to the "Act to adjust the Debts due from this State" due him for
 a Horse furnished Lees Legion per certificate of M^cLane adjusted.—

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Clements sixty nine Pounds,
 ten shillings & three Pence specie agreeable to the Act aforesaid per
 Certificate of Joshua George adjusted.—

That the Armourer deliver to Lieut Edward Hamilton two
 hundred & fifty musket Cartridges on Account of the Continent.—

That the western shore Treasurer pay to William West ten Pounds,
 five shillings & six Pence specie agreeable to the Act to adjust the
 Debts due from this State per Account passed.—

Permission given to Major John Lynch of this State to apply to
 his Excellency General Washington or the Officers commanding at
 the Out Posts of the American Army for Leave to go into the City
 of New York for the purpose of transacting private Business.—
