From the peculiar circumstances of Benjamin Wilson a soldier who was discharged from the Invalid Regiment the 15th September 1782 who formerly belonged to Col^o Hazens Regiment and Hugh M^cCoy of the German Regiment discharged from the Invalid Regiment the 15th Sept^r 1782 and were Citizens of this State it being impossible for them to obtain Certificates required by Law. The Board are of opinion that the Commissioner for settling and adjusting the Accounts of the Troops &^{ca} ought to grant them Certificates for their Depreciation to August 1780, taking their own Oaths; there being no other way of ascertaining it, for the Time when they enlisted.—
