On Friday the 15<sup>th</sup> of November 1782 The General Assembly of Maryland proceeded to the Choice of a Governor, when the Honorable William Paca Esquire was elected; and on Saturday the 16<sup>th</sup> of the same Month the General Assembly elected the following Gentlemen Council to the Governor, Benjamin C. Stoddert, Gabriel Duvall, Jeremiah Townly Chase, James Brice and John Hoskins Stone Esquires.—
