That M^r Shaw deliver to M^r Wasteneys twelve Muskets, two hundred Musket Cartridges, and twelve rounds 4^{1b} fixed Ammunition for which M^r Steward is to be accountable.—

The Council having agreed to furnish a party of men under the Command of Serjeant Suit ordered to West River to Guard the State Ship building at M^r Stewards, with some Articles of necessary Clothing—the Question was put, If the Intendant has not Blankets, shall be directed to buy them.—

Ibid. [B. Stoddert Pres^{dt} in Council to M^r Stephen Steward]

We have yours by M^r Wasteneys—As to the Head for the Ship, we cannot agree to any additional Expence. As to the Spar Deck, you must go on with it, agreeable to the former Determination. We have sent Sergeant Suit with 12 Men, to guard the Ship, and we have also sent to your Care, for which you are to be accountable, twelve spare Musquets, 200 Musquet Cartridges, and twelve Rounds of 4^{lbs} fixed Ammunition. We would recommend to you, to fix some Signal with your Neighbours, to come to your Assistance in Case of Danger.
