

Whereas Overton Carr of Prince Georges County, did on the 16 Day of March 1781 enter into Bond with this Board in the penal Sum of two thousand pounds gold or Silver, that he would not depart the County aforesaid without leave being first obtained of the Governor and Council Be it known to whom it may concern, that from a change of Circumstances it is no longer deemed necessary to confine M<sup>r</sup> Carr to the County aforesaid and he is therefore to go at large and to remove from place to place as Business or Inclination may prompt him, in the same manner he could have done previous to executing the said Bond any thing contained therein to the Contrary notwithstanding.—
