 Said Court that it appeared to them from the Deposition of Joseph
 Harrison that John Moran sailed from the Port of Baltimore in
 June 1782 that he was the same Month made Prisoner by the Enemy
 carried into New York and there detained until the Peace took place
 and Recommending him and his Surety William Price as Objects of
 Mercy and the Board taking the same into Consideraion do remit
 the forfeitures of the said John Moran and William Price.—
