Commission of Letters of Marque & Reprisal issued to Cha<sup>s</sup> Alexander Commander of the Ship General O Reiley two hundred and thirty Tons burthen navigated by fifty men, mounting fourteen Carriage Guns, belonging to George Meade & Comp<sup>y</sup> of Philadelphia.—

Ordered That the western shore Treasurer pay to L<sup>t</sup> James John Skinner fourteen pounds, five shillings and three pence of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &<sup>ca</sup> for Stores to the 1<sup>st</sup> and also thirty pounds of the same Emission in lieu of a Suit of Cloaths and four Shirts for the present Year on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Green two hundred and sixty four pounds, nineteen shillings and five pence of the same Emission to be delivered over to Daniel Hopkins & Comp<sup>y</sup> due them on a Certificate issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State.

That the said Treasurer pay to Joshua Spears two hundred & thirteen pounds, seven shillings of the same Emission to be delivered over to Zephaniah Spiars Capt & his Company of Militia due them p pay rolls passed.

That the said Treasurer pay to Col<sup>o</sup> Edward Lloyd one thousand three hundred & forty nine pounds, thirteen shillings and one penny of the same Emission for ten Certificates dated Novem<sup>r</sup> 6. 1778
