Lower stood John Crosse N. P. Signed Sealed & deliuered in th<sup>e</sup> p<sup>r</sup>sence of us wittnesses & was subscribed Andrew Creaghe, William Whately. Vnder is written.

Memorandu' th<sup>t</sup> because th<sup>e</sup> originall Bill of Sale (whereof the aboue written is th<sup>e</sup> true & authentick Copie) taken out of th<sup>e</sup> Register of mee th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Crosse notary Publick in Amsterdam) is sent by sea for England, & that this goeing by th<sup>e</sup> Post may probably sooner arryue in England then the other, The s<sup>d</sup> Cornelis Van Kuyck & Peter Backer (w<sup>th</sup>out preiudice of th<sup>e</sup> former Act allready made) haue Likewise for testimony & confirmaōn of th<sup>e</sup> p<sup>r</sup>mises here under putt their Seuerall hands & Seales in Amsterdam this Seuenth day of ffebruary 1659 (stilo nouo) & I th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> notary haue likewise sett my usuall & Customary hand, firme & Seale, Datum ut supra.
