These are therefore to will & requyre yo<sup>w</sup> to take th<sup>e</sup> Body of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Pope Aluey, & him keepe in safe Custody w<sup>th</sup>out Bayle or Maynprize, And haue him att Our next Prouinciall Court to bee holden att S<sup>t</sup> Maries 5<sup>o</sup> Aprill next, & this Our Writt. Wittnes Our Deare sonne & heyre &c: Gyuen att S<sup>t</sup> Maries 7<sup>o</sup> March 1663.

Bee it knowne unto all men by these p<sup>r</sup>nts, That I Walter Pakes, for & in Considerāon of a marriage betweene Henry Aspinall, & Mary th<sup>e</sup> eldest Daughter of me Walter Pakes, I th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Walter Pakes doe hereby Giue, graunt & confirme to th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Henry for diuers good considerāons mee mouing thereunto, Three hundred Acres of Land, knowne by th<sup>e</sup> name of S<sup>t</sup> Lawrence Neck to him th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Henry Asspinall, his heyres, & th<sup>e</sup> heyres of th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Mary for euer, Provided th<sup>t</sup> if in Case th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Mary shall dye issuelesse (w<sup>ch</sup> god forbid) That then th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Three hund<sup>d</sup> Acres, aboue mentioned, shall bee to the only use & property of him th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Henry Aspinall during his naturall Life, And then to enure & bee to th<sup>e</sup> only behoofe of him th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Walter Pakes and his heyres, w<sup>th</sup>out any further trouble or molestāon, as wittnes my hand this 2<sup>d</sup> day of March 166<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>
