 in Choptanck Riuer in Talbott County, & Conueyed & sold unto th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup>  
 ffrancis Armstrong by Edward Lloyd Esq.

[p. 229] And th<sup>e</sup> agrement is such That th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis Armstrong and  
 ffrances his Wife haue acknowledged th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Three Parcell of Land,  
 Contayning in th<sup>e</sup> whole, ffowre hund<sup>d</sup> & ffifty Acres, w<sup>th</sup> th<sup>e</sup> appurte  
 teñces to bee th<sup>e</sup> right of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Richard Preston, as those w<sup>ch</sup> th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup>  
 Richard hath of th<sup>e</sup> gswift of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis & ffrances his Wife. And  
 th<sup>e</sup> same they haue remised & Quitt claymed from them & their heyres,  
 to th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Richard Preston, & his heyres for euer. And further  
 th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis & ffrances haue graunted for them & their heyres, th<sup>t</sup>  
 they will warr<sup>t</sup> to th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Richard, & his heyres, th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Three  
 hund Acres of Land, Contayning ffowre hund<sup>d</sup> & ffifty Acres as  
 afores<sup>d</sup>, w<sup>th</sup> th<sup>e</sup> appurteñces agst them th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis & ffrances for  
 euer. And for this Recogniçon, Remission, Quitt, Claime, ffine &  
 Concord th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Richard hath gyuen unto th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis & ffrances full  
 satisfaction, wherew<sup>th</sup> they acknowledge themselues fully & amply  
 satisfied & payd.
