Wherefore hee prayeth Ord<sup>r</sup> of this Hon<sup>ble</sup> Court for Speedy paym<sup>t</sup> therein according to the tenor of the Said Specialty w<sup>th</sup> Costs & da<sup>m</sup>ages—And as in duty bound hee shall pray &<sup>c</sup>
