A Proclamation

Whereas att the last Prouinciall Court holden att S<sup>t</sup> Maries for this Prouince 21<sup>th</sup> february last 1662, The next Prouinciall Court was then appoynted to bee held on the first Tuesday in June following being the second day thereof, Now for as much as the holding of that Court on th<sup>e</sup> second of June as afores<sup>d</sup> will proue most inconuenient, whereas th<sup>e</sup> Gou<sup>r</sup> & Councell can not then conueniently meete together, Being pressed w<sup>th</sup> some urgent occasions of the Prouince, w<sup>ch</sup> can not suffer Delay.

These are therefore to giue notice to all p<sup>r</sup>sons whom it may concerne, That I haue adiorned the s<sup>d</sup> Court to bee held as afores<sup>d</sup> untill the Eight day of Septemb<sup>r</sup> next, And that all writts & other Processe issued for that Court, intended to bee holden 2<sup>d</sup> day of June next, shall bee Returnable on th<sup>e</sup> Eight day of Septemb<sup>r</sup> as afores<sup>d</sup>. Gyuen under my hand this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May, att S<sup>t</sup> Maries 1663.
