Will<sup>m</sup> Whittle dds writt ag<sup>st</sup> John Edmondson Attorney of Cap<sup>t</sup> John Horne acc<sup>o</sup>n Case to th<sup>e</sup> releas of Ten Thows<sup>d</sup> pownds of Tob.

Warr<sup>t</sup> to th<sup>e</sup> sheriffe Caluert County to arrest &c: Ret. next Proinciall Court to bee holden &c: 8<sup>o</sup> Septemb<sup>r</sup> next.

Vid. fol. 25<sup>o</sup> Cecilius &c: To the sheriffe of S<sup>t</sup> Maries County Greeting. Know yee that Elionor Martyn, who was th<sup>e</sup> Wife of ffrancis Martyn of s<sup>t</sup> Hieroms in th<sup>e</sup> County of S<sup>t</sup> Maries, Came into Our Prouinciall Court & Petitioned ag<sup>st</sup> Patience Martyn the Widow of Will<sup>m</sup> Martyn, heyre to ffrancis Martyn, all of s<sup>t</sup> Hieroms in th<sup>e</sup> County of S<sup>t</sup> Maries, To haue the Third part of Two hund<sup>d</sup> Acres of Land, Lying & being in S<sup>t</sup> Hieroms afores<sup>d</sup> of w<sup>ch</sup> th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis dyed seized, To bee assigned her as her Dower & to bee possessed of th<sup>e</sup> Remynder of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Land, in Right of her sonne Lodowicke Martyn, heyre att Law to his eldest Brother Will<sup>m</sup> Martyn afores<sup>d</sup>. The s<sup>d</sup> Patience Martyn came & produced a Will in wryting Proued in our office for Probate of Wills & Testam<sup>ts</sup> & Graunting Adm<sup>stra</sup>o<sup>ns</sup>, whereby th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Will<sup>m</sup> Martin the s<sup>d</sup> Land to him from his ffather ffrancis Martyn descended to th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Patience & Margaret Martha & Dorothy Needham her Children had deuised. Wherefore itt was Considered by th<sup>e</sup> Court That th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Elionor ought to recouer the Thirds of all th<sup>e</sup> Lands w<sup>ch</sup> descended from th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis to the s<sup>d</sup> Will<sup>m</sup> Martyn, And therefore Wee Command yo<sup>w</sup> That yo<sup>w</sup> cause full posses<sup>n</sup> & seisein of th<sup>e</sup> aboues<sup>d</sup> third part by Elionor afores<sup>d</sup> ag<sup>st</sup> the s<sup>d</sup> Patience demanded to bee gyuen to th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Elionor. Wittnes our Deare Brother Philip Caluert Esq<sup>z</sup> Our Chancelo<sup>r</sup> of Our s<sup>d</sup> Prouince this 21<sup>th</sup> day of January 1662. Philip Caluert.
