 death, wee being Sworne and hauing ueiued the said Haggmans  
 Body doe finde no mortall wound about him that did occasion his  
 death but doe unanimously concurr and Judge the s<sup>d</sup> Haggman being  
 a diseased person died of the scuruey and an Imposthume Wittnes  
 Our handes August the 28<sup>th</sup> 1664—
