

Liber B B singular his tennem<sup>t</sup> or plantacon comonly called and knowne by the name of Kaytings plantacon beginning att a marked Oke standing neer the fence side by the edge of the Clear'd ground and running East into th<sup>e</sup> woods for the length of two hundred perches to a marked Oke bounding on the East w<sup>th</sup> a line drawne south from the said Oke for the length of One hundred & twenty perches to a marked maple on the south w<sup>th</sup> a line drawne west from the end of the former [p. 502] line for the length of two hundred perches untill it intersects a paralell line drawne from the first marked Oake on the west w<sup>th</sup> the said paralell on the North w<sup>th</sup> the East line Containing and now laid out for One hundred acres of land more or lesse w<sup>th</sup> appurtenances and houses Edifices buildings tobacco howses and all Out houses Orchards Gardens thereunto belonging To haue and to hould to him the said Thomas Kayton his heires Executo<sup>rs</sup> Administrato<sup>rs</sup> and Assignes all & singular the p<sup>r</sup>misses w<sup>th</sup> the appurtenances for euer yealding and thereout yearely paying unto the said William Caluert his heires Executo<sup>rs</sup> Administrato<sup>rs</sup> or Assignes One Bushell of Indian Corne at or by the tenth of Nouember at the Mansion howse of the said William Caluert in Caluerts Rest and One Barrill of Corne for Herriott and in Case the said yearely rent be behinde and unpaid w<sup>th</sup>in tenn dayes before or after the said time of paym<sup>t</sup> that it shall and may be lawfull to and for the said William Caluert his heires Executo<sup>rs</sup> Administrato<sup>rs</sup> and Assignes to distraine upon th<sup>e</sup> p<sup>r</sup>misses and for want of sufficient distresse to reenter and th<sup>e</sup> same to hold and enjoy as his or theire former Estate And the said William Caluert doth binde himselfe his Heires Executors Administrato<sup>rs</sup> and Assignes to warrant and defend the p<sup>r</sup>misses unto the said Thom: Kayting his heires Executo<sup>rs</sup> Administrato<sup>rs</sup> and Assignes from all Just Claimes whatsoever In wittnes whereof the s<sup>d</sup> William Caluert and Audrey Kayting alias Daly Guardian to the said Thomas Kayting haue to these Indentures Inter Changeably sett their handes and seales the day and yeare aboue written
