 sand six hundred sixty Three, Assume uppon himselfe to pay yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>r</sup>  
 or his Assignes the sume of nineteene hundred seauenty ffie pounds  
 of tobacco, To be paid the next ensueing Cropp as by specialty und<sup>r</sup>  
 the said Thompsons hand may more att large appeare

Now soe it is The said debt of 1975<sup>th</sup> tob: by yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>r</sup> hath been  
 often demanded, but the said Thompson hath and still doth refuse  
 to make satisfacōn therein, To the greate damage of yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>r</sup>  
 whereuppon he bringeth his suite—

And humbly Craues Order ags<sup>t</sup> the said Thompson for the said  
 suñe of nineteene hundred seauenty ffie pounds of tobacco w<sup>th</sup>  
 damages and Cost of suite—And he shall euer pray &<sup>c</sup>.

 yeare after the date thereof Vt supra—
