That whereas the said Thomas Gerrard by his deed bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of January w<sup>ch</sup> was in the yeare of Our Lord 1653 did demise and to farme lett unto Thomas Dinniard One tract of land Containing three hundred acres of land scituate lying and being in the County aforesaid To haue and to hould unto the said Thomas Dinniard his Executo<sup>rs</sup> and Assignes for and during the tearme of twenty and one yeares from thence forth, for and in Considera<sup>o</sup>n of and under the scuerall Couenants Clauses prouisoes payments and agreem<sup>ts</sup> in the said Demise men<sup>o</sup>ned & Contained and on the part and behalfe of the said Thomas Dinniard his Executors and Assignes to be done and p<sup>r</sup>formed as by the said deed of demise Rela<sup>o</sup>n thereto being had more at large appeareth, And that in Case the said Thomas his executo<sup>rs</sup> or Assignes or any of them shall faile in pay- [p. 41]  
ing or p<sup>r</sup>forming any or all the s<sup>d</sup> Couen<sup>ts</sup> Clauses prouisoes paym<sup>ts</sup> and agreem<sup>ts</sup> in part or in all that then and in such Case and from & after such faileing and paym<sup>t</sup> the said deed and demise to be uoid, and the demised p<sup>r</sup>misses and euery part and parcell thereof to Re-  
turne be and Continue unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Gerrard his heires and Assignes as if such demise had neuer been made, And yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>r</sup> in fact saith, that the said George King Assignee of the said Tho: Dinniard hath not p<sup>r</sup>formed the said Couenants, for that he hath not paid the rent reserued thereby: att the time therein and thereby appointed to be paid but the same hath denied to pay unto yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>r</sup> to his Da<sup>m</sup>age of twenty thowsand p<sup>n</sup>ds of tobacco and therefore he bringeth his acc<sup>o</sup>n—
