For Elioner Keeting Cropt on the left Eare and 2 slitts; the right eare underkeelld: and Ouer Keel'd—

For Mary Keeting Cropt on the left Eare and 3 slitts: the right Eare underkeell'd w<sup>th</sup> a hole in it, & the tipp of the Eare Cutt of—

For his owne Childe by name Bryan Daley Cropt on the right Eare and 2 slitts thereon the left eare underkeeld and a hole & Cropt

For his owne proper marke w<sup>ch</sup> was long since dēd. to M<sup>r</sup> Gittings to be recording but nothing appeareing, hee againe Enters it as foff: Cropt on the left eare and 2 slitts the right eare Cropt, and under-keel'd and a hole in it—

Marmaduke Snow of Mattapenny gen<sup>t</sup>: Complaineth ags<sup>t</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Boreman of S<sup>t</sup> Marys County gen<sup>t</sup>: for that the said Boreman hauing bought of the p<sup>l</sup>t<sup>f</sup> nineteene head of Cattle (uizt) ffue steeres One Bull two Cowes two Heifers nine yearlings for the su<sup>m</sup>e of six thowsand fue hundred pounds of tobacco as by a writing und<sup>r</sup> the said Boremans hand doth appeare by which the p<sup>l</sup>t: saith he is endebted to him the su<sup>m</sup>e of six thowsand fue hundred pounds of tobacco as aforesaid, the which said su<sup>m</sup>e of six thow-sand fue hundred pounds of tobacco the said Boarman utterly re-fuseth to pay Contrary as he humbly Conceiues to law and Justice, Whereupon he bringeth his accōn and humbly prayeth Order of this Hon<sup>ble</sup> Court for speedy paym<sup>t</sup> thereof And he shall pray
