But Richard Newell being incapable to satisfy in Tob. or goods because a seruant, It's ordered th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Newell stand Three Courts in th<sup>e</sup> Pillory w<sup>th</sup> his fact written in Capitall Letters ouer his head, And that hee bee gyuen Twenty Lashes on th<sup>e</sup> bare back euery Court And further ordered th<sup>t</sup> th<sup>e</sup> sheriffe forthw<sup>th</sup> take him into Custody, & bring him to euery Court, till this order of Court bee fullfilled. In this Cause referred from Caluert County to this Prouinciall Court where it appears that Thomas Sprigge being then High sheriffe of that County, did willfully suffer or permitt Richard Newell (being his Prisoner & putt into his Custody by order of that County Court) to Escape, & not suffer punishm<sup>t</sup> according to th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Order. It is therefore ordered, by reason of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Spriggs connyuance, & willfull permittance of escape in th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Prisoner That th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Sprigge bee fyned to th<sup>e</sup> Lord Proprietary in the sume of Two Thows<sup>d</sup> pounds of Tob. And It is further ordered th<sup>t</sup> th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Sprigge bring Richard Newell his fores<sup>d</sup> Prisoner to th<sup>e</sup> next County Court to bee held in Caluert County, there to suffer such punishm<sup>t</sup> as hee was ordered to suffer & as was intended by th<sup>t</sup> County Court, And in case th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Sprigge doe not produce or bring th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Prisoner to th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Court as afores<sup>d</sup> Then it is further ordered th<sup>t</sup> th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Sprigge pay Two Thows<sup>d</sup> pounds of Tob. more, That is to say seauenteene hund<sup>d</sup> pounds of Tob. to Cuthbert ffenwick for his dammage &c: And Three hund<sup>d</sup> pounds of Tob. for a ffyne to th<sup>e</sup>
