place, Will<sup>m</sup> Moffett of Virginia in th<sup>e</sup> parts beyound th<sup>e</sup> seas Planter, <sup>Moffetts L<sup>r</sup>e</sup>  
my true & Lawfull Attorney for mee & in my name & to & for my <sup>of Attorney</sup>  
use, to aske demand, leauy, recouer & receiue all such debt & debts  
su<sup>m</sup>e & su<sup>m</sup>es of money as are to me due oweing or payable by any  
p<sup>r</sup>son or p<sup>r</sup>sons whatsoever in Virginia afores<sup>d</sup> by bond, bill, booke  
specialty or by any other wayes or meanes whatsoever or howsoeu<sup>r</sup>,  
Gyuing & hereby graunting unto my s<sup>d</sup> Attorney my full power &  
authority in th<sup>e</sup> Exequuon of the p<sup>r</sup>mises, And for mee & in my name  
to arrest, sue, imprison, & impleade all & euery such p<sup>r</sup>son & p<sup>r</sup>sons for  
all & euery such debt & debts, su<sup>m</sup>e & su<sup>m</sup>es of money as are to me  
due oweing or payable as aforesayd, And to recouer in euery such  
suite & suites & to sue out execūon & Execūons uppon euery such  
Recouery & recoueries according to th<sup>e</sup> Lawes, And also to acquitt, [p. 87]  
compownd for, & discharge th<sup>e</sup> same, And all accōns suites Judgm<sup>ts</sup>  
& exequūons th<sup>t</sup> shall concerne th<sup>e</sup> same, Attorneys one or moe in  
th<sup>e</sup> p<sup>r</sup>mises under him to substitute, & th<sup>e</sup> same att his pleasure to  
reuoake, And further to doe, or procure to bee done all such other  
Lawfull & reasonable act & acts, thing & things, as shall bee needfull  
& expedient in or about th<sup>e</sup> premises, in as large & ample manner and  
forme, in euery respect, as I my selfe might or could doe, if I were  
present, Ratifying & allowing all & whatsoever my s<sup>d</sup> Attorney shall  
Lawfully doe, or cause to bee done in or about th<sup>e</sup> p<sup>r</sup>mises by these  
p<sup>r</sup>sents. In wittnes whereof I haue hereunto sett my hand & seale.  
Gyuen th<sup>e</sup> sixth day of August Año dñi 1662, & in th<sup>e</sup> ffowrteenth  
yeare of the Reigne of our Soueraigne Lord Charles th<sup>e</sup> second by  
th<sup>e</sup> Grace of God, of England, Scotland, ffrance, & Ireland King,
