
[p. 93] And the Agreem<sup>t</sup> is such that the s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis Jackson hath acknowledged th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Three hund Twenty ffive Acres w<sup>th</sup> the appurtānces to bee the Right of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Luke Barbier, as those w<sup>ch</sup> th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Luke Barbier hath of th<sup>e</sup> guift of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis Jackson, And th<sup>e</sup> same hee hath Remised Released & Quitt Claymed from him and his heyres to the afores<sup>d</sup> Luke Barbier & his heyres for euer, And further th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis Jackson hath graunted for him & their heyres of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis that hee will warrant to th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Luke Barbier & his heyres th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Three hund<sup>d</sup> Twenty & ffive Acres w<sup>th</sup> th<sup>e</sup> Appurtānces ag<sup>st</sup> him th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis Jackson and th<sup>e</sup> heyres of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> ffrancis for euer. And for this Remise, Release, & Quitt Clayme th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Luke Barbier hath gyuen unto th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> ffrancis Jackson Six pence.
