In wittnesse whereof the parties aforesayd to these p<sup>r</sup>sent Indentures interchangeably haue putt their hands & seales. Dated the day & yeare first aboue written.

Commis<sup>n</sup> Exiuit to impower M<sup>r</sup> Henry Adams to admīster oath to M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Mathews M<sup>r</sup> Zachary Wade & M<sup>r</sup> Humphrey Haggett to serue as Commis<sup>rs</sup> in Charles County.

To all Christian Poep<sup>l</sup>e to whom these p<sup>r</sup>nts shall come Greeting, Know yee that I John Jarbo of Maryland Gent<sup>n</sup> haue absolutely bargayned & sold & receiued full satisfaction for all my Right, Tytle & interest of & in th<sup>e</sup> moetie of th<sup>e</sup> plantaōn now in th<sup>e</sup> occupaōn of Walter Hall, formerly of Henry ffox, who by will bequeathed th<sup>e</sup> same to th<sup>e</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Hall & my selfe, after th<sup>e</sup> Death of his sonne Henry ffox, All w<sup>ch</sup> Right & interest (if euer it shall fall to mee, The Moitie or all by Halls Death or Child) I doe by these p<sup>r</sup>nts fully & absolutely dispose of as aboues<sup>d</sup> unto Luke Barber of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Prouince allsoe. As wittnes my hand this 12<sup>th</sup> of Aprill One Thowsand six hund<sup>d</sup> ffifty & eight
