Know all men by these p<sup>r</sup>nts th<sup>t</sup> I Cornelius Stenwick merch<sup>t</sup> of New Amsterdam in new Netherlands haue made ordayned deputed & constituted my louing ffreind M<sup>r</sup> Rob<sup>t</sup> Slye of Maryl<sup>d</sup> merch<sup>t</sup> my true & lawfull Attorney for mee & in my name & to my use to aske demand sue for Leuy & receaue from th<sup>e</sup> Admīstrato<sup>r</sup> of th<sup>e</sup> Estate of Samuel Smith of Maryland Merch<sup>t</sup> Deceased all such sume or sumes of mony, goods, wares merchantdises thing or things whatso<sup>r</sup> due, oweing or belonging to mee, Bee itt by Bill booke, obligaōn or acc<sup>t</sup>, or by any other meanes or wayes whatsoe<sup>r</sup>, Gyuing & by these p<sup>r</sup>nts graunting unto my s<sup>d</sup> Attorney my full power & Lawfull authority to sue attatch arrest imprisone & condemne, & out of prison to release, And of and uppon th<sup>e</sup> receipt thereof to giue acquittances or any other lawfull discharge for mee & in my name to make saile deliuer, Attorneys one or more under him to substitute, make or att their pleasures to remoue, And futhermore to use, doe exequite & p<sup>r</sup>forme all & euery lawfull matter Act things necessary whatsoe<sup>r</sup> to bee done in th<sup>e</sup> premises, as fully wholly & effectually as though I my selfe were p<sup>r</sup>sonally p<sup>r</sup>nt, Ratifying & allowing all & whatsoe<sup>r</sup> my s<sup>d</sup> Attorney shall doe in th<sup>e</sup> premises by uertue of these p<sup>r</sup>nts.
