Receaued of him moreou<sup>r</sup> Eleauen hund<sup>d</sup> pownd, & nine & Twenty pownds of Tob for six peices of silk damask & some wampom att my full contentm<sup>t</sup> receaued of him Gisbertson afores<sup>d</sup>. Wherefore I doe promise to deliuer & pay th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Tob unto him or his Attorney att Contentm<sup>t</sup> att Amsterdam in th<sup>e</sup> New Netherlands, Allso one assignaōn of Cap<sup>t</sup> Jacob w<sup>ch</sup> I accept to pay as afores<sup>d</sup> Amounting to th<sup>e</sup> su<sup>m</sup>e of fflowre hund<sup>d</sup> Guilders att six pence p<sup>r</sup> 3812<sup>t</sup> Tob. Amounting all together the su<sup>m</sup>e of 3812<sup>t</sup> Tob, to bee deliuered underland as unto the Lawes. Acted Amsterdam in th<sup>e</sup> New Netherlands this 6<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1660 Signed Sam: Smith
