for mee & in my name & to my use to aske recouer & receaue the sume  
& iust quantity of seauen hund<sup>d</sup> Twenty fower pownds of currant  
Tob. out of th<sup>e</sup> Estate of Sam: Smith Deceased, according to Bill  
as appeareth in date th<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> of May 1660 oweing unto mee from th<sup>e</sup>  
s<sup>d</sup> Smith, And by these p<sup>r</sup>nts graunting unto my s<sup>d</sup> Attorney to use  
arrest implead all meanes necessary w<sup>ch</sup> shall bee needfull or neces-  
sary to bee done in or about th<sup>e</sup> Debt, the same to doe as fully &  
wholly as I my selfe might doe if I were there p<sup>r</sup>sonally p<sup>r</sup>nt, And  
uppon th<sup>e</sup> Receipt of any sume to my use of th<sup>e</sup> Estate afores<sup>d</sup> to  
giue acquittance & discharge for th<sup>e</sup> same for mee & in my stead &  
name, Holding firme & stable & whatsoeu<sup>r</sup> my s<sup>d</sup> Attorney shall doe  
or cause to be done in or about th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Debt by these p<sup>r</sup>nts. Sealed
