Know all men by these p<sup>r</sup>nts that I John Legatt of Charles County Clerke doe Constitute ordaine & appoynt M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Nottley my true & Lawfull Attorney, in my name & steed to answer & plead to Two Acc<sup>o</sup>ns commenced ag<sup>st</sup> mee by th<sup>e</sup> L<sup>d</sup> Prop<sup>r</sup> att th<sup>e</sup> next Provinciall Court to bee held att S<sup>t</sup> Maries th<sup>e</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> instant, And what my s<sup>d</sup> Attorney shall doe or cause to bee done in rela<sup>o</sup>n to the same I doe hereby ratify allow & confirme to bee substantiall & ualuable to all intents & purposes, as if I my selfe were there p<sup>r</sup>sonally p<sup>r</sup>sent att th<sup>e</sup> doing thereof. To w<sup>ch</sup> Informa<sup>o</sup>n John Legatt, by his Attorney, pleads not Guilty, And th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Lumbrozo, not being able to make iust proove of what is alleaged by him, The Informa<sup>o</sup>n is Judged nothing.

M<sup>r</sup> Richard Smith informes th<sup>e</sup> Court how th<sup>t</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Manning ioyned in marriage w<sup>th</sup>out eyther Lycence, or asking th<sup>e</sup> Banes according to Act of Assembly, or other publica<sup>o</sup>n Will<sup>m</sup> Chaplin & Mary Richardson, W<sup>ch</sup> beeing confessed by him,

Ordered th<sup>t</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Manning pay ffuue Thows<sup>d</sup> pownds of Tob the one moiety to th<sup>e</sup> informer, & the other moiety to th<sup>e</sup> L<sup>d</sup> Proprietary, And th<sup>t</sup> th<sup>e</sup> p<sup>r</sup>sons married pay One Thows<sup>d</sup> pownds of Tob, the one halfe to th<sup>e</sup> L<sup>d</sup> Proprietary, & the other halfe to th<sup>e</sup> Informer as afores<sup>d</sup>.

M<sup>r</sup> Attorney gräll p<sup>r</sup>f } Moses Stagwell, (being called) informes th<sup>e</sup> William Ellyote Dēft } Court how th<sup>t</sup> Richard Blunt High Sheriffe of th<sup>e</sup> Isle of Kent came to the howse of th<sup>e</sup> Deft, to demand Certaine Tob. due uppon Exequūon, w<sup>ch</sup> the deft refused to pay, Whereuppon hee Layd his Exequūon for part uppon a Boate, w<sup>ch</sup> boate Abraham Bishop att th<sup>e</sup> Instiga<sup>o</sup>n of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Ellyote carried away not suffering it to bee apprayed. And further th<sup>t</sup> th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> sheriffe sett th<sup>e</sup> Broad arrow uppon Ellyots Tobacco howse dore, w<sup>ch</sup> th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Ellyote rased out in contempt of th<sup>e</sup> Law & order prouiding in th<sup>t</sup> behalfe & Gouverm<sup>t</sup> here. The Tob demand<sup>d</sup> by Moses Stagwell (M<sup>r</sup> Richard Blunts Vndersheriffe is ffor sheriffs ffees Leuies &c: 320<sup>t</sup> Tob, ffor Cfks ffees 90<sup>t</sup> Tob, for want of planting Corne according to Act of Assembly 300<sup>t</sup> Tob.
