

Liber B B Two hund<sup>d</sup> Acres of Land, Lying & next adioyning unto th<sup>e</sup> Land of Richard Gorsuch uppon th<sup>e</sup> Deuiding Creeke, Running out of Armestrongs Bay in Choptank Riuer (Viz<sup>t</sup>) beginning att th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Gorsuch his northermost Bownded Tree, being a Red Oake markd w<sup>th</sup> ffowre notches, Running for breadth northerly downe th<sup>e</sup> Bay one hund<sup>d</sup> perches to a small marked Ceadar markt w<sup>th</sup> fowre notches the Length into th<sup>e</sup> woods northeast, according to th<sup>e</sup> Pattent thereof ffor him th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Armstrong & his heyres to Enioy th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Land w<sup>th</sup> all th<sup>e</sup> priuiledges & immunities thereunto (according to Pattent) belonging for euer, w<sup>th</sup>out th<sup>e</sup> Lett, molestaōn or perturbaōn of mee th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Edward Lloyd my heyres or Executo<sup>rs</sup> or any other p<sup>r</sup>son or p<sup>r</sup>sons, chalenging or clayming under mee according to Law, And shall uppon Lawfull Call passe th<sup>e</sup> same Deed in Court. [p. 131] Memorand<sup>m</sup> that Mary Vtye the Relict of Lawrence Ward, to whom & her heyres, the Estate of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Lawrence was by his Last Will & Testam<sup>t</sup> demised, Did on th<sup>e</sup> Sixth day of Nouemb<sup>r</sup> 1662 att Spes-Vtia in Baltemore County A Certaine Patent by th<sup>e</sup> Lord Proprietary graunted to ffrancis Van Eynden for Two hund<sup>d</sup> & ffifty Acres of Land in Patux<sup>t</sup> Riuer, As also another Patent by his s<sup>d</sup> L<sup>p</sup> to Thomas Warr for ffowre hund<sup>d</sup> Acres in th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Riuer Graunted, Together w<sup>th</sup> another pattent to Hugh Hopewell & Thomas White for ffifty Acres of Land in th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Riuer Graunted, did before mee Philip Caluert Esq<sup>z</sup> Chancelo<sup>r</sup> of this Prouince to th<sup>e</sup> use of the R<sup>t</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary surrender: As also a Certaine Bill of Sale dated 18<sup>th</sup> June 1657 for Ten Acres of Land in th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Riuer from John Holfehead to her th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Mary Vtye, th<sup>e</sup> Relict of Lawrence Ward, to his s<sup>d</sup> Lordship did assigne & sett ouer, as Wittnes my hand this Tenth of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1663.
