Liber H. S. County, who is hereby authorized and directed to collect the same; and the said Money when so collected, shall be paid to the said Vestry and Churchwardens, or the Majority of them, who are hereby authorized and required to apply the same towards Railing in, or Paling the Grave Yards, at the Church and Chapel aforesaid, and repairing the same, in such Manner, as to the Vestrymen and Churchwardens of the said Parish, for the Time being, shall seem most iust and reasonable.

No. 18 An Act to enable the Parishioners of Part of Saint Andrew's Parish. in Saint Mary's County, to choose Vestrymen and Churchwardens, and to enable the Visitors of the County School, in said County, to choose Visitors.

Whereas, neither the Act entituled, An Act for Establishment of [Preamble.] Religious Worship, or any other Law within this Province, doth enable Part of a Parish, to choose Vestrymen and Churchwardens,

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's p. 34 Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the [Part of a qualified Inhabitants of that Part of Saint Andrew's Parish, in Saint Parish in St. Mary's County, separated from the Parish which the Reverend meet and Mr. Tabbs now holds, by the Death of the Reverend Lawrence De choose Ves-trymen and Butts, late Incumbent thereof, to meet on the last Tuesday in Novem-Church- ber, in the Year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Three, wardens.] at the Court-House of the said County, and then and there to choose Six Vestrymen, and two Churchwardens, being Freeholders within the said Part of Saint Andrew's Parish aforesaid, which Vestrymen and Churchwardens so chosen, and their Successors, are hereby declared to be the Vestrymen and Churchwardens of and for the said Parish, and they are hereby authorized and impowered to act and do whatever appertains to the Duty of Vestrymen and Churchwardens, by the Laws of this Province; such Vestrymen and Churchwardens qualifying themselves to act as such, agreeable to Law.
