In Case it shall be thought proper to apply the Sum of 1999 l. 11 s. L. H. J. 11 d. 2 q. in the Hands of the Treasurers, for his Majesty's Service, Liber No. 47 in Aid of the Virginians, then the Sum of 4000 l. 8 s. 0 d. 2 q. may be taken out of the Loan Office, for the same Service, and repaid by the p. 478 Ways and Means reported by this Committee; but is humbly submitted to your Honourable House.
