 of maryland whom it may concern are to take notice & to order  
 their affairs accordingly And we do hereby Ord.<sup>r</sup> & Command our  
 Respective Sheriff of our Severall Countys that they upon Sight of  
 this our proclamation do Imediately publish and proclaim the Same  
 And Give the Respective deputies & Delegates of their Severall  
 Counties particular notice of our will & pleasure therein Witness
