Charles &<sup>c</sup> To Clement Hill & Rich<sup>d</sup> Loyd of S.<sup>t</sup> marys Co.<sup>ty</sup> Gent Greeting We Coñand you that by the Oaths of Twelve Good & Lawfull men of our S.<sup>d</sup> County of S.<sup>t</sup> marys by whom the truth of the matter may the better be known & Enquired of you diligently Enquire who is the Right owner & heir of a tract of Land Called the mill Land Lying at the head of Brittan's Bay in our S.<sup>d</sup> County of S.<sup>t</sup> marys & of what manno.<sup>r</sup> & what age the heir is & under what Rents & Services & how much those Lands and Tenem.<sup>ts</sup> are of value by the year in all issues & who those Land and Tenem.<sup>ts</sup> hath or doth Occupy & the issues & profits hath or doth receive & by what Title and how & in what manner & who hath paid the Rent for the Same & to whom & the Inquisition thereof distinctly and openly made to us in our Chancery under yo.<sup>r</sup> hands & Seals & the hands & Seals by whom it Shall be made without delay you Send & this Writt Wittness our Self dat 15.<sup>th</sup> June 1678

Charles &<sup>c</sup> To Ignatius Mathews of Charles County Greeting We Command you that Imediately after the Sight hereof you pay unto W.<sup>m</sup> Gwyther of S.<sup>t</sup> Mary's Co.<sup>ty</sup> or the bearer of this writt the Summe of Six thousand two hund.<sup>d</sup> & Seven pounds of Tobacco, Costs adjudged him the S.<sup>d</sup> W.<sup>m</sup> Gwyther by o.<sup>r</sup> Court of Chan.<sup>ry</sup> in a Cause there depending between him the s.<sup>d</sup> W.<sup>m</sup> Comp.<sup>lt</sup> & you defend.<sup>t</sup> & hereof you are not to fail under the pain Ensueing Wittness our Self at our City of S.<sup>t</sup> marys y.<sup>e</sup> 5.<sup>th</sup> day of July in the third year of our Dominion &<sup>a</sup> Annoꝝ Dom 1678

John Hartwell maketh Oath that upon the third day of Octob.<sup>r</sup> Instant he did deliver to m.<sup>r</sup> John Breed of Charles Co.<sup>ty</sup> a writt of Subp.<sup>a</sup> issued out of the high Court of Chancery of which this is a Copy under the Seale of this Court & that the S.<sup>d</sup> Ignatius Mathews & his mother the wife of m.<sup>r</sup> John Breed was then & there p<sup>r</sup>sent & this Depon.<sup>t</sup> did then demand of the S.<sup>d</sup> Ignatius & his s.<sup>d</sup> father
