An Inquisition Indented taken at the house of George Yate in Ann Arundell County in the Province of Maryland the Two and Twentieth day of Aprill 1679 and in the fourth year of the Dominion of the Right Hon.<sup>ble</sup> Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltemore &c.<sup>a</sup> By us Rowland Nance and John Thomas By Virtue of a Writt of Mandamus issued out of his Lordship's high Court of Chancery to this Inquisition annexed to us directed By the Oath of John Larkin, Richard Beard, Richard Cheiny Sen.<sup>r</sup> Rich.<sup>d</sup> Cheiny Jun.<sup>r</sup> Robert Wade, John Gray, John Belt, William Jones, William Iiams John Jacob, John Tate and Thomas Plummer The Jury who upon their Oaths as followeth viz.<sup>t</sup> That the Said Richard Mascall at the time of his departure out of this Province which was in the year of our Lord one thousand Six hundred and Seventy three was in actual possession of a Tract of Land Containing two hundred & thirty acres more or Less as appears by Certificate Surveyed by George Yate then Deputy Surveyo.<sup>r</sup> in the year of the Dominion of the Right Hon.<sup>ble</sup> Cæcilius of most noble memory and in the year of our Lord God one thousand Six hundred & Seventy Scituate Lying & being in Baltemore County but formerly in Ann Arundell
