Cæcilius &c To Richard Tilghman & to his Councello.<sup>rs</sup> attorneys agents and Solicitors & to Every of them Greeting Whereas we were Informed by our Court of Chancery the Twelfth day of Ap.<sup>ll</sup> last past on the Behalf of Nicholas Brookes plaintiff ag.<sup>t</sup> thee def.<sup>t</sup> that the plaintiff having Exhibited his Bill of Comp.<sup>lt</sup> into our Said Court to be Relieved ag.<sup>t</sup> an Açon at Law by thee brought ag.<sup>t</sup> the plaintiff to w.<sup>ch</sup> Bill thou didst Crave time till next Court to put in an Answer and the Same was Ordered accordingly and that our writt of Injunçon Should issue out of our S.<sup>d</sup> Court to Stay thy proceedings at Law till thou hadst answered the Said Bill whereof we takeing due Consideration do hereby Strictly Charge and firmly Enjoyne thee the s.<sup>d</sup> Richard Tilghman and you his Councillo.<sup>rs</sup> and attorneys Agents & Sollicitors and Every of you under the pain of five hundred pounds Sterling to be Leavyed of yo.<sup>r</sup> Goods & Chattles Lands and Tenements to our use that from henceforth you Stay Surcease and forbear all further prosecution whatsoever at the Common Law ag.<sup>t</sup> the plaintiff upon the Said açon or for or touching any other matter in the Said Bill Complained of untill you the Said defend.<sup>t</sup> Shall put in a full and perfect Answer to the Said Bill and this Court take other order to the Contrary Teste 16 Sept 39<sup>o</sup> Domini 1670
