By virtu of the within ord<sup>r</sup> wee the within named Thomas Notley  
 and Thomas Lomax have veiwed Examined stated and audited the  
 whole busines within mentioned. And thereupon doe humbly p<sup>r</sup>sent  
 unto this hono<sup>ble</sup> Court this our Reporte in manner and forme fol-  
 lowing (viz<sup>t</sup>).

Wee finde due to the Comp<sup>lt</sup> from Edward Richardson upon the  
 Account of the Copartnership (all private debts Reciprocally be-  
 tweene them being defalcated and fully discompted) the Just sume  
 of Tenne Thowsand Eight hundred and ninety pounds of Tobacco.

p. 19 Secondly Wee doe reporte that the Comp<sup>lt</sup> ought to beare his pro-  
 portion of what bad Debts (if any there be) relating to the said  
 Copartnership. Given und<sup>r</sup> our hands the sixteenth day of October  
 in the fortieth year of the Dominion of the Right hono<sup>ble</sup> Cæcilius  
 &<sup>c</sup> over this Province and in the yeare of our Lord 1671.

Upon w<sup>ch</sup> foregoing Reporte of the Said M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Notley, and

It is this day ordered that the Defend<sup>t</sup> Rozer, Keepe what Tobacco  
 he hath in his hands untill the next Co<sup>rt</sup>, and then that he bring in an  
 account of what bad Debts their are belonging to the Copartnership,  
 and that the Comp<sup>lt</sup> and his Attorney be then p<sup>r</sup>sent to make their  
 Exceptions, against the said Rozers account, that the Justices of this  
 Court perusing th<sup>e</sup> same, and hearing what both partyes can alledge  
 may doe therein as to Justice apperteynes.
